SPEYSIDE

KNOWN FOR

The greatest number of distilleries of any region in Scotland, small area but produces varied flavour profiles: The light and grassy notes found in the Glenlivet (#1 selling scotch in the US) to the sweeter sherry notes of Glenrothes

USUAL SUSPECTS

Macallan, Glenfiddich and the Glenlivet - The three best selling Scotches in the world.

TRIVIA

James Bond "Skyfall"- Javier Bardem's character drinks Macallan 1962, which was recently auctioned for \$15,000. Mad Men's set is littered with Glenlivet, in the Netflix released season 4 of arrested development, Maeby Funke orders Macallan 12.

Highlands & Islands

It is the largest landmass out of the 5 whisky regions and has over 50 distilleries the producing an extensive array but only account for 1/5 of the whisky production in Scotland.

The oldest distillery in Scotland can be found at Crieff, called the Glenturret which has went by two other names in it's past - Thurot and later Hosh.

Speyside

Has 50 distilleries, of which the oldest was started in 1786 called Strathisla which is still in operation today.

Islay

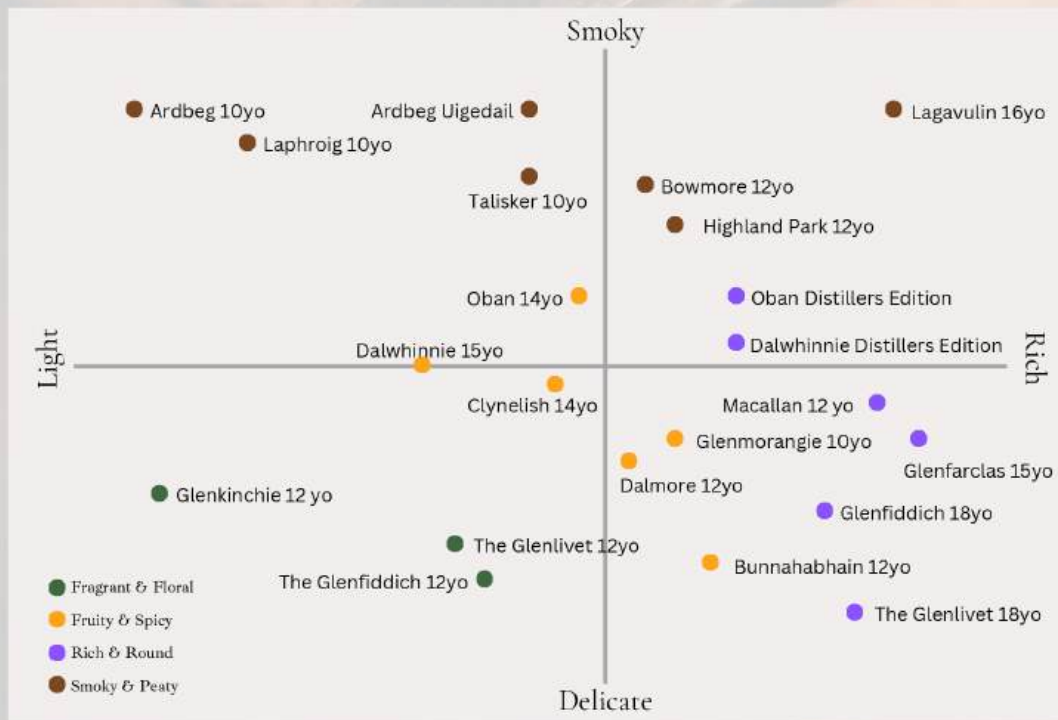
Pronounced EYE-luh, Islay is a small island yet is seen by many as an important place for whisky lovers who travel far to go to these distilleries.

Lowland

With 18 distilleries the lowlands produce whisky which are often lighter and are a perfect introduction for those wanting to get into single malts
